Prominent litigator and mediator will be Of Counsel to firm

Miami-based litigation boutique **Hall, Lamb and Hall (HLH)** announces the addition of prominent attorney **Jon Zeder**, who will join the firm as Of Counsel. Mr. Zeder will be an active member of the firm's litigation team, working on a wide range of complex commercial cases, while continuing to serve as a mediator Certified by the Supreme Court of Florida.

He also will support pending cases by mentoring associates at the firm on critical aspects of the practice, including written and oral advocacy, trial preparation, jury selection, and client management. Prior to joining Hall, Lamb and Hall, Mr. Zeder was of counsel to Katz Barron Squitiero Faust. Before that, he was a "senior partner" and member of the executive and management committees at Ferrell Law. He previously worked for 32 years with the firm of Paul & Thomson, a successor to that firm, Thomson Zeder Bohrer Werth Adorno & Razook, and Adorno & Zeder, formed by a former partner at Thomson Zeder.

"As one of the most respected litigators in the community, Jon is known for his integrity and relentless advocacy of his clients' interests before the court," said Hall, Lamb and Hall Managing Partner Andrew C. Hall. "We have been good friends for many years, and have worked extensively together as co-counsel in a major litigation matter. I am delighted to have him join our firm in this more formal capacity."

Founded in 1975, HLH has counseled and tried cases arising out of some of the nation's most significant recent historical events, including the Watergate and Plumbers trials, the failure of the Ohio banking system, the terrorist attack in 2000 on the USS Cole, and Cuba's persecution of Americans in retaliation for their anti-communist positions. Currently, the firm is working on a variety of complex cases, including legal malpractice matters, continuing to collect on its \$2.8 billion verdict against Cuba, and representing Steven Hayworth in his fraud and breach of contract claims against Gibraltar Bank, to name a few.

Mr. Zeder is a Life Fellow of the American Bar Foundation, an honorary organization of attorneys, judges, and law professors whose careers have demonstrated outstanding dedication to the welfare of their communities and to the highest principles of the legal profession. Outside of the courtroom, Mr. Zeder has been involved in a number of professional and community organizations. He is a former Vice Chairman of the Greater Miami Chamber of



Commerce and a member of its executive committee. He is a past president and director of the Two Hundred Club of Greater Miami, an organization dedicated to benefitting the families of firemen and police officers killed in the line of duty. He is also the former director of the Development Advisory Council for the Miami Center for Orthopedic Research and Education ("Miami CORE") at the University of Miami Miller School of Medicine.

Mr. Zeder earned his undergraduate degree in Economics from Brown University and his Juris Doctor, With Honors, from the University of Florida College of Law, where he served on the editorial board of the law review.
